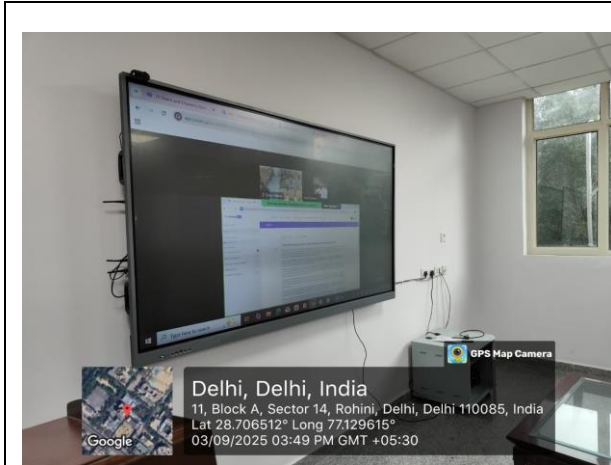


LANGUAGE GURU- DIGITAL LANGUAGE LAB
