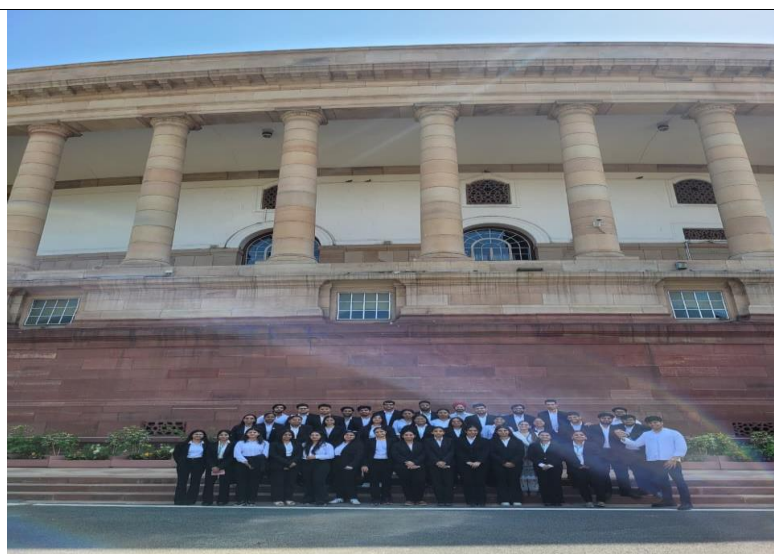


VISIT TO PARLIAMENT OF INDIA, NEW DELHI
