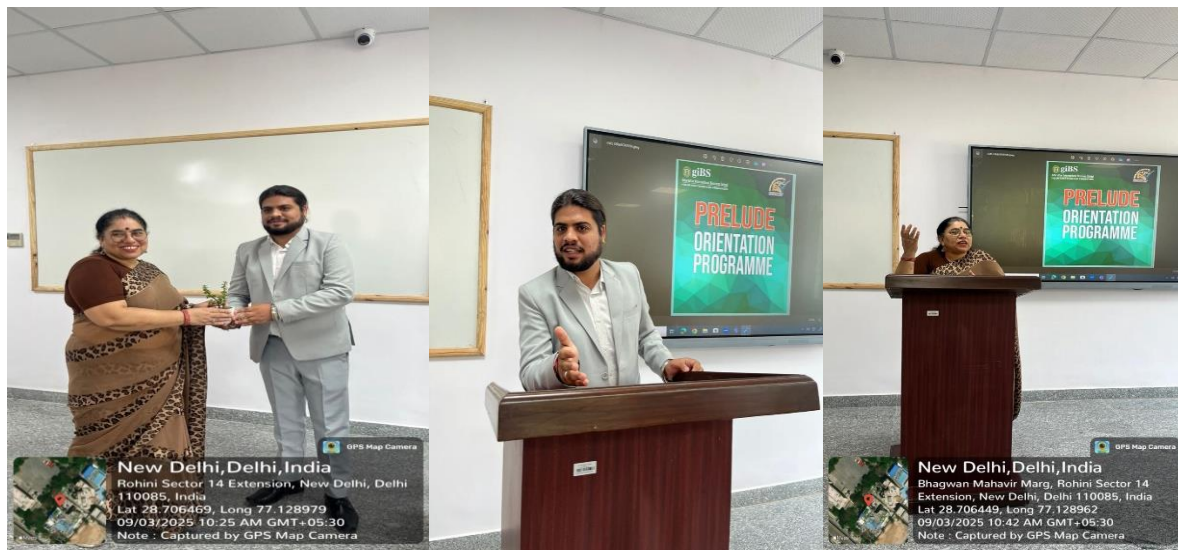


PRELUDE ORIENTATION PROGRAMME
