## “AWAAZ DO (NAARI SASHAKTIKARAN)”

The Legal Aid Clinic of Gitarattan International Business School organized a Legal Awareness Programme in collaboration with the District Legal Services Authority (North) and SPUWAC (Special Police Unit for Women and Children), Delhi Police, with the objective of creating awareness among young women law students regarding women empowerment and legal rights. The programme was conducted under the theme “Awaaz Do (Naari Sashaktikaran)”, focusing on gender justice, women-centric legislations, and institutional mechanisms available for protection, redressal, and support to women facing violence or discrimination.

The session aimed to sensitize students about their constitutional and statutory rights, the role of legal aid institutions, and the importance of timely reporting and legal intervention in cases of gender-based violence.

The session was conducted by the esteemed resource person, Mr. Rishabh Tanwar, Ld. Secretary, District Legal Services Authority (North), Delhi. With his extensive experience in legal aid administration and access to justice mechanisms, the resource person delivered a comprehensive and practically oriented session, highlighting the functioning of DLSA and the remedies available to women under various legal frameworks.

Mr. Tanwar elaborated on the role of DLSA in providing free legal aid, counselling services, mediation, and victim support. He explained the procedure for filing complaints, accessing legal assistance, and the importance of institutional support systems in safeguarding women's rights. The session included real-life examples and interactive discussions, which enabled students to better understand the practical aspects of legal aid delivery.

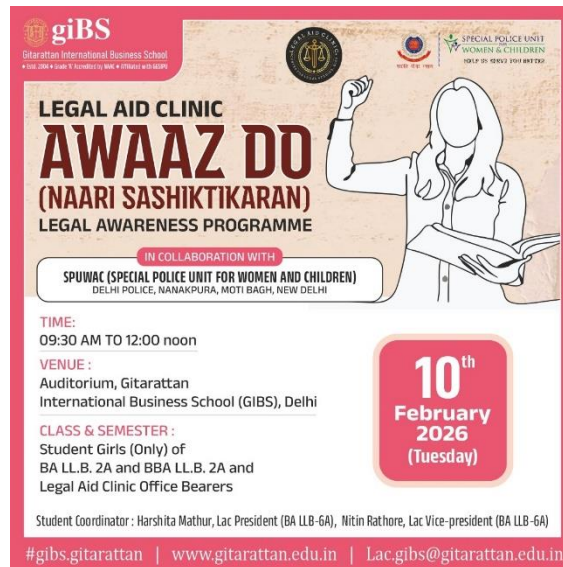
