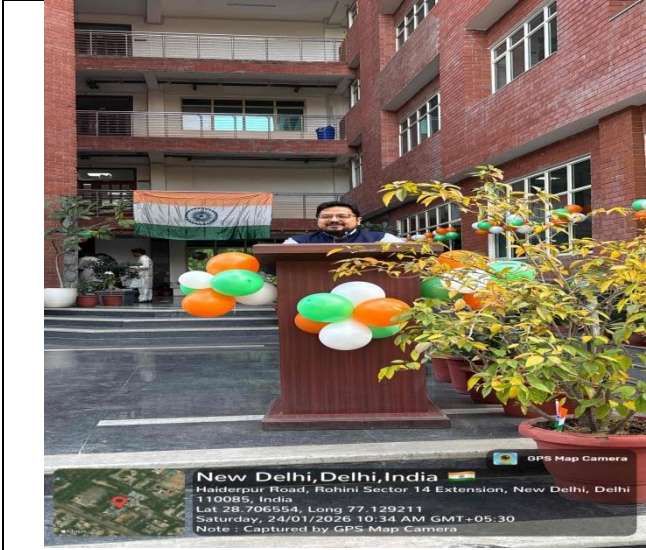
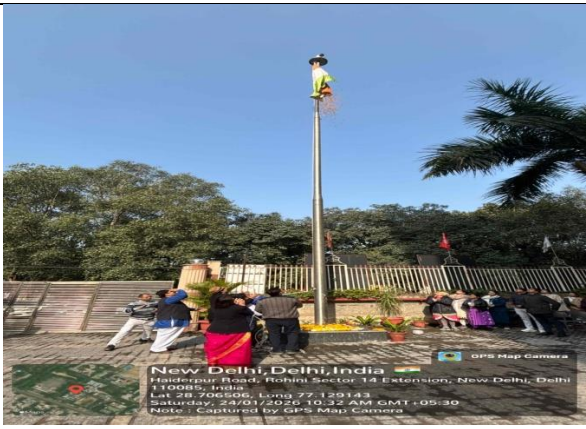


# 77<sup>TH</sup> REPUBLIC DAY CELEBRATION

## 24<sup>TH</sup> JANUARY 2026 (SATURDAY)
