Gitarattan International Business School (GIBS), under the aegis of the Institution’s Innovation and Entrepreneurship Cell (IIC), successfully organized a One-Day Intra-College Hackathon titled “Innovate for Impact: Hackathon on Law, Management & Governance” on 2nd February 2026. The hackathon was designed to promote innovation-driven problem solving, interdisciplinary collaboration, and practical application of law, management, technology, and governance concepts among students. The event commenced with a green welcome of Prof. (Dr.) Abhijit and Dr. Manisha Kaushal Arora by Prof. (Dr.) Manisha Nain, followed by the green welcome of Dr. Anjali Gupta by Dr. K.K.B. Tomar.

Total students registered in this event were 56 and students participated were 38 with 24 teams. Participants presented innovative solutions addressing real-world legal and managerial problems aligned with the prescribed themes. Each presentation covered the problem statement, proposed solution, impact, and feasibility, followed by an interactive Q&A session with the judges.

A total of ten themes were provided to the participants, from which they were required to select one and work on it by identifying a relevant problem and proposing an appropriate solution, with guidance and assistance from the assigned mentors mentioned below:
