The Centre for Legal Studies Gitarattan International Business School organized an Academic visit to the Parliament of India for BALLB 2<sup>nd</sup> semester students on 17<sup>th</sup> February 2026. The aim of the visit was to make students more aware about the parliamentary procedure and get a closer view of the legislative organ of the country the maker of all laws.

The visit started by gathering at the Parliament library where the students witnessed a video made on the construction of the new parliament building. The students then got an opportunity to meet and interact with the Director Lok Sabha secretariat Mr. Raj Kumar. Sir explained about the entire working procedure of the parliament and how a bill is passed in the parliament. Sir very kindly answered all the questions and queries of the students. After the interaction ended the walk to the parliament started. The students were taken to the old parliament building first and they witnessed the central hall of the parliament where the historic transfer of power from britishers to India took place in 1947 and the historic speech of our first Prime Minister Shri Jawaharlal Nehru took place. It is this central hall where all the joint sessions of the parliament had been conducted so far.

Then the students were taken to the new parliament building where they witnessed the beautiful galleries created on the theme of diverse cultural heritage of India. There was a beautiful display of different musical instruments, dance forms and heritage buildings of the different states of India. Then the students were taken to the Lok Sabha which is built on the theme of the peacock and the Rajya Sabha built on the theme of the lotus. Both the houses of the new parliament building are beautifully decorated and equipped with modern technology.

It was a wonderful experience for the students to witness the epitome of democracy in India the Parliament of India.
