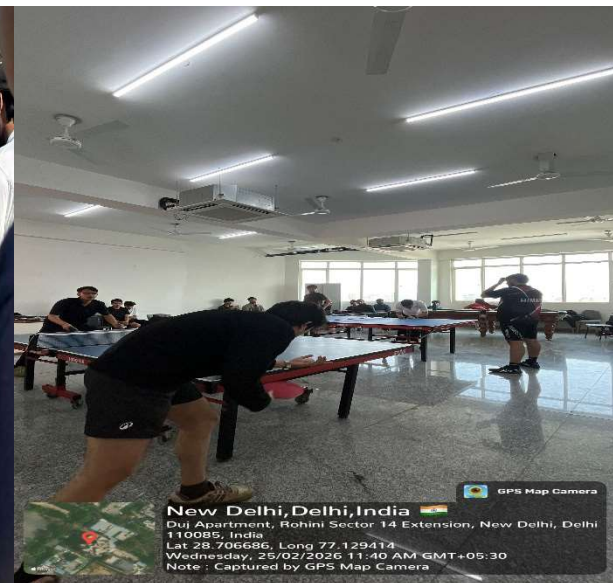
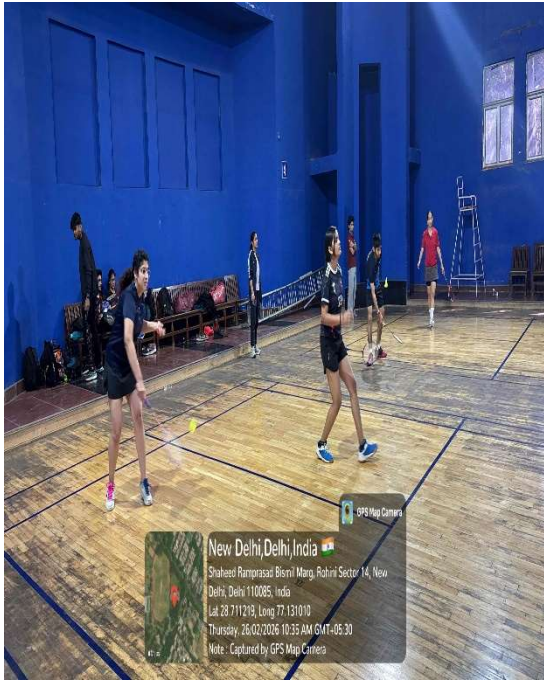
DAY ONE – 25th Feb 2026
