

VISIT TO HON'BLE DELHI HIGH COURT
16TH – 19TH MARCH 2026
(MONDAY- THURSDAY)



Gitarattan International Business School successfully organized an academic visit for the students of Integrated BB.A. LL.B. (4A & 4B), 4th Semester, to the Hon'ble Delhi High Court from 16th to 19th March 2026. The visit commenced at 11:00 A.M. onwards. The primary objective of the visit was to provide practical exposure to students regarding the functioning of the High Court and to enhance their understanding about the judicial system.

This Visit helped students appreciate the coordination required within the justice delivery system. Prior to entering the courtroom, the faculty coordinator briefed the students about the rules, security protocols, and decorum to be maintained inside the court premises.

During the visit students visited all the courtrooms where specific courtroom is allotted to deal with particular types of cases, like civil courts, criminal courts, courts dealing with matters of Bail. Students were divided into groups of 4 to 5 students and each group visited different Courtrooms to understand the way and body-language of Advocates while delivering the Arguments and a comprehensive understanding on diverse legal proceedings.

The students visited Courtroom No. 1, where the Bench of the Hon'ble Chief Justice of Delhi High Court was presiding. They witnessed arguments related to different matters such as constitutional matter, which was a remarkable and enlightening experience. Observing live court proceedings allowed students to gain insight into courtroom advocacy, judicial reasoning, and procedural conduct.

Students also visited the newly constructed Lawyers Chamber where the office of Delhi International Arbitration facility located. They also visited old building of Lawyers Chambers where they encountered with few lawyers to get practical knowledge and to boost up their Career opportunities.

By this visit students developed an understanding about the practical aspect of the litigation, and complexities associated with the lawyering, judicial working and judicial administration. Students also get a chance to visit Delhi High Court Library where they explored a wide range of

Legal Books written by legal jurists. The academic visit to the Hon’ble Delhi High Court proved to be an insightful and enriching experience. It provided students with a practical understanding of legal procedures, courtroom etiquette, and the functioning of the judicial system. Observing real-life proceedings helped bridge the gap between theoretical knowledge and its application. Overall, the visit enhanced our awareness, critical thinking, and interest in the field of law.
