

## VISIT TO THE DELHI VIDHAN SABHA 16<sup>TH</sup> APRIL 2026 (THURSDAY)

The Centre for Legal Studies, Gitarattan International Business School (GIBS), organized an academic visit to the Delhi Vidhan Sabha on 16<sup>th</sup> April 2026 for the students of Integrated B.A. LL.B. (Hons.) as part of experiential learning under Constitutional Law and legislative studies. A total of 32 students participated in the visit. The objective of the visit was to provide practical exposure to the functioning of the legislative branch of government and to help students understand the institutional processes involved in law-making at the State level.

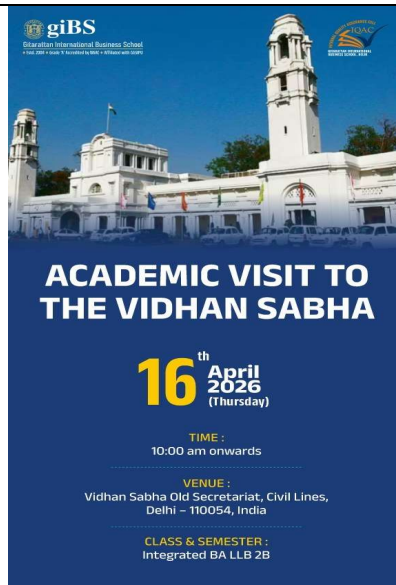
