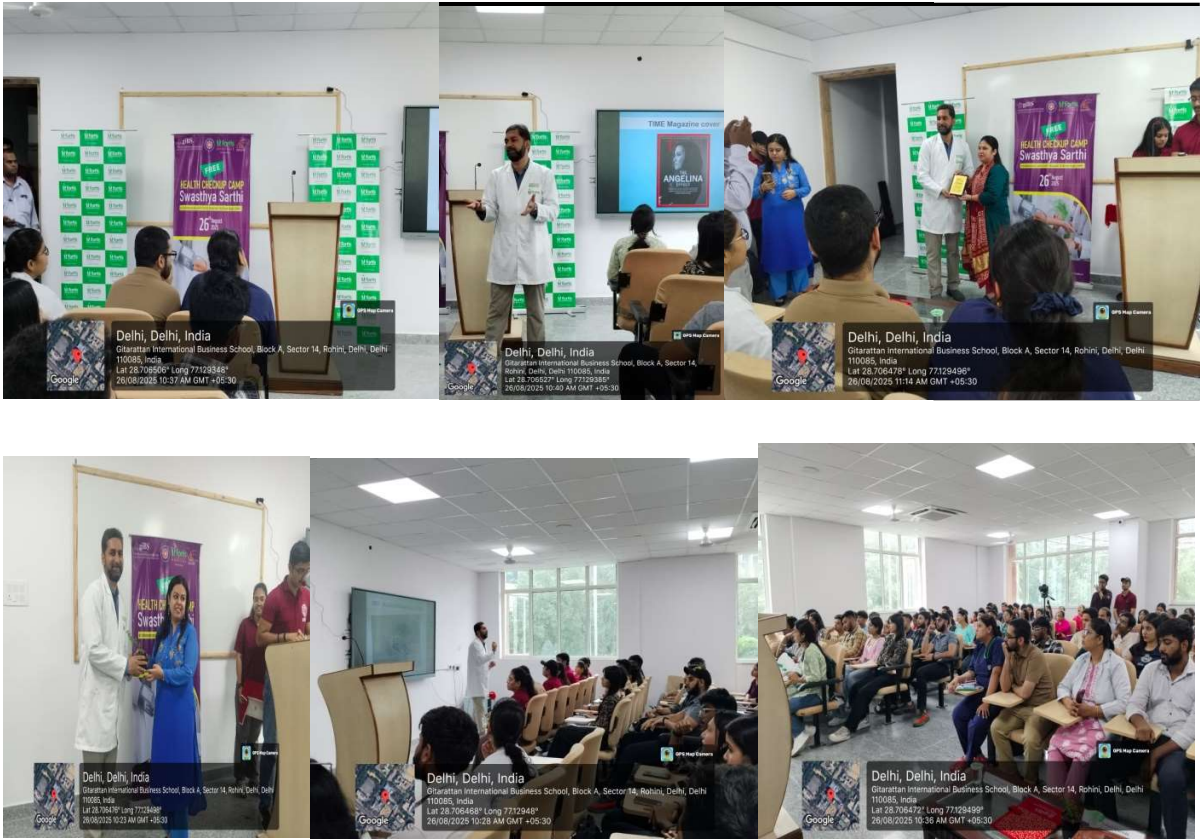


HEALTH AWARENESS TALK ON MYTHS AND FACTS ABOUT CANCER

26TH AUGUST 2025 (TUESDAY)



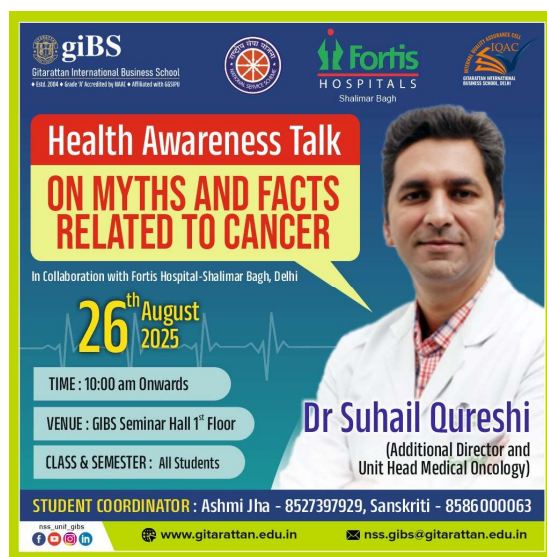
