

BLOOD DONATION CAMP

11TH & 13TH FEBRUARY 2025 (TUESDAY, THURSDAY)



The NSS Unit of Gitarattan International Business School (GIBS) organized a two-day Blood Donation Camp on 11th February 2025, in collaboration with RML Hospital, and 13th February 2025, in collaboration with Lions Club. The event aimed to promote the importance of blood donation and contribute to saving lives by maintaining an adequate blood supply for medical emergencies.

On 11th February, the camp ran from 10:00 AM to 3:30 PM, collecting 56 units of blood, while the second day, on 13th February, the camp took place from 10:00 AM to 1:30 PM, gathering 46 units of blood. The medical team from RML and Lions Club set up a well-equipped donation center in the auditorium within the campus. The event was well-received, with over 175 volunteers registering for donation. The medical team conducted preliminary health check-ups, including blood pressure, hemoglobin levels, and overall fitness assessment, before proceeding with the donation.

After the donation, participants were awarded certificates of appreciation and refreshments. Lions Club also gifted a mug to the donors as a token of gratitude. The overwhelming participation and successful collection of a total of 102 units of blood across both days reflected the commitment of students, faculty, and staff towards social service and humanitarian efforts. Volunteers from the NSS unit actively assisted in managing the event and ensuring smooth operations.

The Blood Donation Camp was a resounding success, reflecting the compassion and social commitment of the GIBS student community. Such initiatives instill a sense of responsibility and encourage students to contribute to humanitarian causes. The NSS unit looks forward to organizing similar events in the future to continue this noble mission.
