

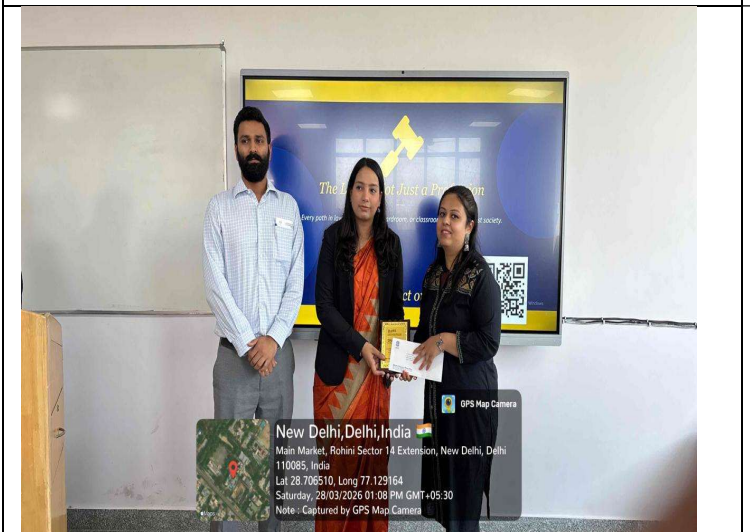

The Alumni Lecture Series (ALS), organized by Gitarattan International Business School (GIBS) on 28<sup>th</sup> March 2026, was conducted as part of the institute's ongoing initiative to guide students toward informed career decisions and broaden their professional perspectives. The session titled "Beyond the Bar: Exploring Career Pathways After Law School" aimed to enlighten students about the diverse opportunities available beyond traditional litigation and courtroom practice.

Students actively participated, raising thoughtful questions about career planning, skill development, and industry expectations. The interactive discussion created a dynamic learning environment, and participants expressed appreciation for the practical insights shared.
