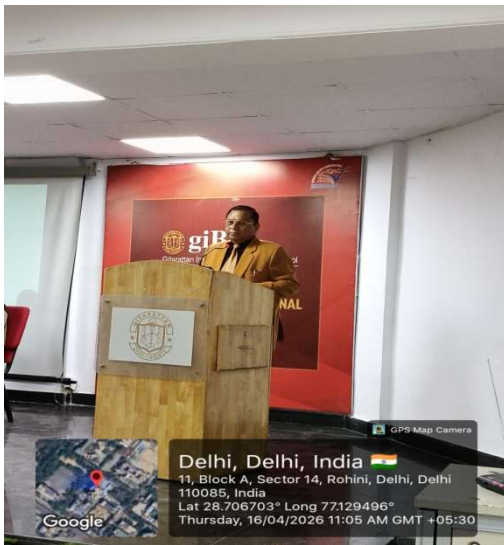


CAREER ADVANCEMENT PROGRAM (CAP)
‘BUILDING A MULTI- DIMENSIONAL LEGAL CAREER IN THE
MODERN ERA’
16TH APRIL 2026 (THURSDAY)



The Centre for Legal Studies (CLS), Gitarattan International Business School, successfully organized a Career Advancement Program (CAP) for students of 4th, 6th, 8th & 10th Semester on 16th April 2026 at the GIBS Auditorium. The session was conducted on the topic “Building a Multi-Dimensional Legal Career in the Modern Era.” The program aimed to guide law students in exploring diverse career opportunities and bridging the gap between academic learning and professional legal practice.

The session was delivered by President of International Council of Jurists, Dr. Adish C. Aggarwala, President of International Council of Jurists and a distinguished legal practitioner with over 35 years of experience. His practical insights, interactive approach, and real-life examples made the session highly engaging and beneficial for the students.

The event commenced with a formal welcome, followed by the introduction and felicitation of the Resource Person. The session then progressed into an interactive and insightful discussion.

During the session, Dr. Aggarwala actively interacted with the students by posing questions regarding their career preferences, particularly in the field of litigation, and how they plan to secure cases in the initial phase of their careers. He emphasized that although individuals such as politicians and social activists often attract cases due to their public visibility, students without such connections can also succeed through perseverance, networking, and consistent effort. He highlighted that success in litigation requires time, patience, and a strong social presence.

Sharing his personal journey, he mentioned his initial experience as a counsel for banks, thereby explaining the scope of corporate legal practice. He emphasized that while marks may not play a decisive role in litigation practice, they are highly significant for careers such as judiciary and other competitive examinations, where academic performance from earlier stages also matters.

The speaker stressed the importance of conceptual clarity and focused learning, advising

students to read legal provisions carefully, understand concepts in their own language, and develop analytical and imaginative thinking. He also highlighted that a lawyer must be socially active and visible, as recognition within society is crucial for building a successful legal practice.

Dr. Aggarwala also provided practical guidance for aspiring legal professionals, including:

- Reading and understanding Bare Acts for practical application
- Maintaining visiting cards for professional networking
- Wearing formal attire to build credibility and trust
- Enhancing marketability and professional identity
- Maintaining a law diary for court observations
- Staying updated through Akashvani news
- Developing effective communication and speaking skills
- Maintaining concentration, focus, and discipline

Career Opportunities Discussed

The session covered a wide range of career opportunities in the legal field. The speaker highlighted that students may opt for academia, such as becoming a lecturer or law professor, where working conditions are stable and rewarding. He also shared his own experience of serving as an executive member in Chanakya University.

Litigation was discussed as a prominent career option, where practical skills and experience hold more importance than academic marks. Other career avenues included:

- Civil Services and State Services (Legal/Administrative roles)
- Indian Legal Services, which advise various ministries and provide access to multiple departments of the Government of India
- Assistant Legal Adviser and Law Officer roles in Public Sector Undertakings (PSUs)
- Corporate Law practice

- Judiciary, including positions such as Civil Judge and ADJ

The session concluded with an engaging question-and-answer round, where students raised several important queries:

- A student inquired about the pathway to becoming an Additional District Judge (ADJ), to which the speaker explained the requirement of relevant legal experience and judicial examination process.
- Students from the fourth and fifth years asked about opportunities in international policy-making, and the speaker guided them towards gaining exposure through government roles and specialization in international law.
- He also highlighted opportunities in international organizations such as WHO and the United Nations, explaining that such positions are generally offered on a contractual basis and are advertised on official platforms.
- A query regarding the scope of arbitration was addressed, where the speaker suggested pursuing diploma courses and gaining specialization in the field.
- The importance of three years of legal practice for judiciary-related roles was also discussed.

He further advised students to stay informed by listening to Akashvani news, maintain strong concentration, and build a professional identity within society. He emphasized that recognition and visibility are key factors for success in the legal profession.

The session proved to be highly informative and enriching for the students. It provided them with a comprehensive understanding of various career paths in law, along with practical strategies for professional growth. The program successfully achieved its objective of guiding students towards building a dynamic, informed, and multi-dimensional legal career.
