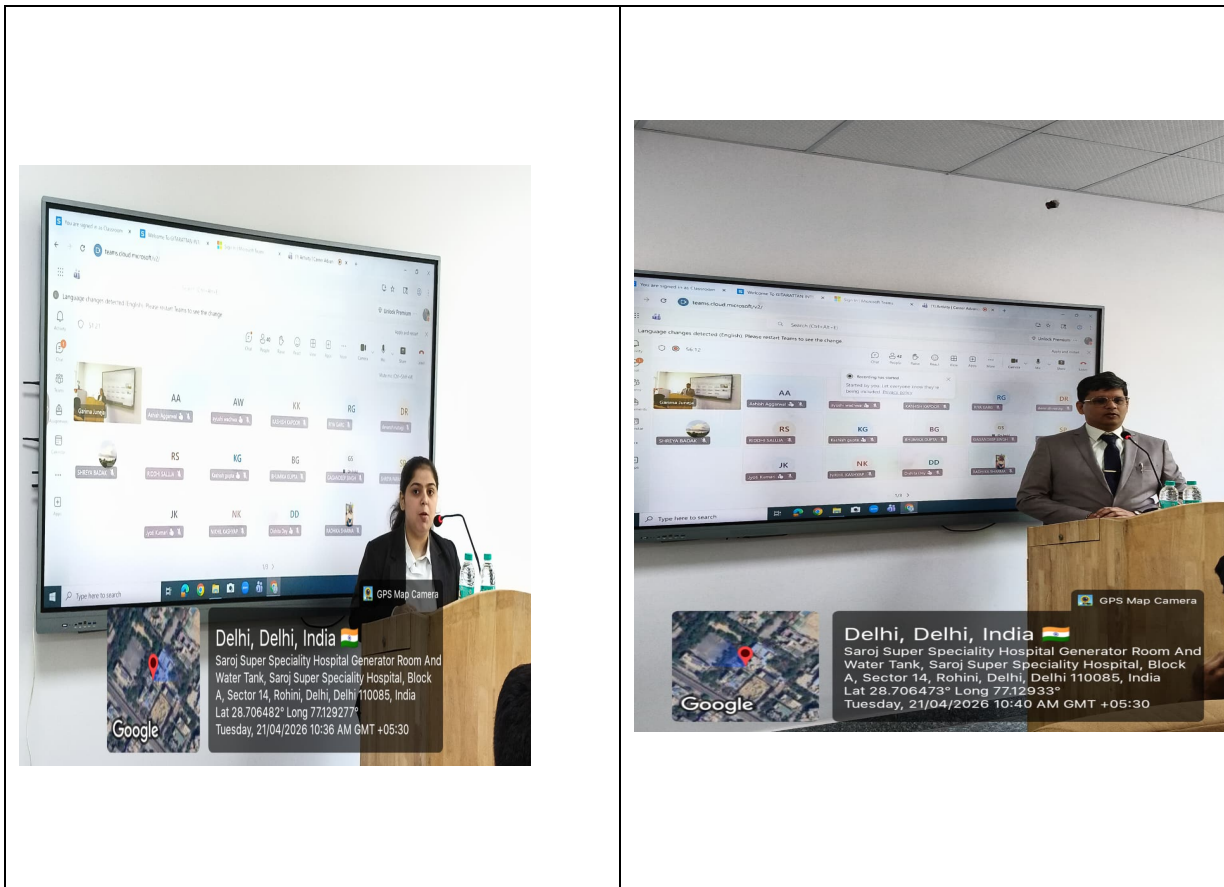


CAREER ADVANCEMENT PROGRAM

PREPARATION AND CORPORATE LEGAL ACUMEN

Students were also made aware of the day-to-day responsibilities of corporate lawyers, including due diligence, regulatory compliance, dispute resolution, and advisory roles in business operations. The discussion also touched upon emerging areas such as arbitration, cyber law, and international business laws, thereby broadening the students' perspective towards dynamic and evolving corporate legal careers.

In addition to this, the speaker provided valuable insights into the importance of internships, practical training, and industry exposure for building a successful career in the corporate field. He encouraged students to actively engage in moot courts, legal research, and professional networking to enhance their skills and employability.
