

# Career Advancement Program on Aptitude and Reasoning for Competitive Examinations

Gitarattan International Business School (GIBS) successfully hosted an insightful and career-oriented session on **Career Advancement Program on Aptitude and Reasoning for Competitive Examinations** on **22nd April 2026 (Wednesday)** for MBA II Semester, MBA IB II Semester, and BBA IV Semester students. The session was designed to enhance students' analytical thinking, logical reasoning, and problem-solving abilities essential for competitive examinations such as CAT, banking, SSC, and other entrance tests. The session aimed to equip participants with practical strategies and conceptual clarity required to tackle aptitude and reasoning sections effectively.

The session was conducted by Resource Person, **Mr. Anmol Upadhyay**, who provided valuable insights into improving logical reasoning skills for competitive examinations. He began by emphasizing the importance of structured thinking and a systematic approach to solving problems in high-pressure exam situations. The session was interactive and engaging, encouraging students to actively participate and apply concepts in real time.

The session provided a comprehensive understanding of logical reasoning through a structured framework. The resource person introduced the **five pillars of logical reasoning**, which form the foundation for solving complex problems efficiently:

- Deconstructing complex problems through analytical thinking
- Recognizing patterns to predict trends
- Applying general rules in deductive reasoning
- Generalizing observations through inductive reasoning
- Solving challenges with a methodological and structured approach

He further elaborated on various types of questions frequently asked in competitive examinations, enabling students to understand different problem-solving techniques and approaches:

1. **Verbal and Non-Verbal Reasoning:**
  - Alphabet-based problems and pattern recognition
  - Coding-Decoding techniques
  - Number series and logical sequencing
2. **Analytical Reasoning:**
  - Seating arrangements and arrangement-based problems
  - Venn diagrams and logical classification
  - Picture-based reasoning and visual interpretation
3. **Logical Puzzles:**
  - Complex puzzle-solving techniques
  - Step-by-step analytical approaches to reach solutions

The core of the session focused on building a strong conceptual foundation and enhancing speed and accuracy in solving reasoning questions. Participants were guided on how to approach different types of questions strategically, manage time effectively during examinations, and avoid common errors.

To further strengthen their preparation, the resource person recommended some of the best books and resources for continuous practice and improvement, including *A Modern Approach to Logical Reasoning* by R.S. Aggarwal, *Puzzles to Puzzle You* by Shakuntala Devi, and *Word Power Made Easy* by Norman Lewis. These resources were highlighted as essential tools for developing proficiency in aptitude and reasoning.

Following the detailed content session, students were engaged in practice-based problem-solving activities that allowed them to apply learned concepts and enhance their confidence. The interactive nature of the session helped in clarifying doubts and reinforcing key concepts, making the learning experience effective and impactful.

As the session progressed, students demonstrated enthusiasm and active participation, reflecting their keen interest in improving their aptitude skills for competitive examinations. The session created an environment of focused learning and intellectual engagement, motivating students to adopt a disciplined and strategic approach to their preparation.
