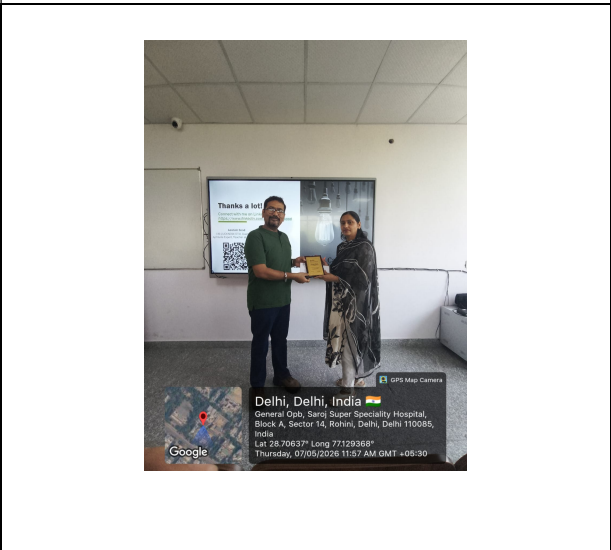


CAREER ADVANCEMENT PROGRAM (CAP)
“MASTERING QUANTITATIVE APTITUDE FOR

The Career Advancement Program (CAP) on “*Mastering Quantitative Aptitude for Competitive Success*” was organized at GIBS on 7th May 2026. The session was coordinated by Ms. Geeta Khari, Assistant Professor, CMS, GIBS and delivered by distinguished guest speaker Mr. Aashish Sood, QA Faculty, Career Launcher. The program was conducted with the objective of preparing BBA and MBA students for competitive examinations such as CAT and UGC-NET by strengthening their quantitative aptitude skills.

The program commenced with a warm green welcome of the guest speaker by the event coordinator, Ms. Geeta Khari. She introduced the significance of quantitative aptitude in today’s competitive academic and professional environment and highlighted the relevance of the session for management students aspiring to excel in entrance and eligibility examinations.

The guest speaker, Mr. Aashish Sood, delivered an insightful and engaging session focusing on core quantitative aptitude concepts and practical problem-solving methods. He explained various topics including arithmetic, algebra, percentages, ratio and proportion, time and work, and data interpretation with exam-oriented examples.

The speaker emphasized the importance of conceptual clarity and regular practice for achieving success in competitive examinations. Students were introduced to shortcut methods, calculation tricks, and time management techniques that could significantly improve speed and accuracy during exams. The session also covered strategies for attempting questions smartly, avoiding common mistakes, and managing examination pressure effectively. On the request of students, Sir also provided brief insights regarding preparation for interviews.

Interactive problem-solving exercises and discussions enabled students to actively participate and clarify their doubts. The practical examples and real examination patterns discussed during the session helped students gain a better understanding of the preparation strategies required for CAT and UGC-NET.
