## 19<sup>TH</sup> ANNUAL CULTURAL FEST

### 21<sup>ST</sup> MARCH 2025 (SATURDAY)

Gitarattan International Business School organized "Zenith-2026," the 19<sup>th</sup> Annual Cultural Fest of GIBS, on 21<sup>st</sup> March 2025 at The Sovereign School, Sec 24, Rohini. The event commenced with a grand inaugural ceremony, where honourable dignitaries, including Vice Chairman Shri Anirudh Jindal, Dean Ms. Prachi Jindal and Director Dr. Prof. Vikas Nath, graced the occasion. The Director Dr. Prof. Vikas Nath welcomed the Chief Guest, Mr. Aditya Arya, Founder of The Museo Camera. The ceremonial lamp lighting and an enchanting Ganesh Vandana performance by the Mudra dance society marked the beginning of the celebration. Thereafter band performance was presented by the students of Raag and the dignitaries proceeded to inaugurate Aalekhya 2026.





Zenith 2026 featured 11 cultural competitions, the 5<sup>th</sup> Annual Art & Photography Exhibition “Aalekhya,” and a grand Star Night with the Punjabi pop singer Ms. Sunanda Sharma. This year, the fest witnessed record participation, with over 1000+ participants from approximately 150+ colleges across Delhi- NCR. The event was captured by our official photography partner Delhi College of Photography (DCOP).

Soon after the main inaugural ceremony, the art and photography exhibition was inaugurated by esteemed guests Mr. Aditya Arya, founder of The Museo Camera and Mr. Ravindra Kumar Tanwar, HOD, Fine Arts, Delhi Police Public School, Dean Ms. Prachi Jindal, GIBS and Director Dr. Prof. Vikas Nath. Aalekhya was a resounding success, showcasing the immense talent of 100 enthusiastic artists and photographers. The event provided a platform for creative expression and artistic appreciation, attracting a diverse audience including students, art enthusiasts, and budding photographers. The exhibition featured breathtaking paintings, photographs, and creative artworks, offering a platform for artists to showcase their imagination. Mr. Ravindra Kumar Tanwar judged the best artwork and best photograph display amongst all and Mr. Aditya Arya judged for the best Jury award. Mr. Ravindra Kumar Tanwar and Mr. Aditya Arya commended the participants for their creativity, technical skills, and storytelling through visuals.

The event included a diverse range of competitions showcasing artistic, cultural, and creative talents:

- **Folk Fusion Fiesta: Folk Dance (Group)**– Teams blended traditional folk dances with contemporary elements, delivering electrifying and culturally rich performances. The judges of the event were Dr. Shruti Gupta, faculty, Gitarattan International Business School (GIBS) and Ms. Sujata, Dance faculty, The Sovereign School (TSS).
- **Rhythmic Voice: A Solo Singing with Instruments Competition**– Vocalists paired their singing skills with live instrumental accompaniment, delivering soulful and powerful musical performances. The judges of the event were Dr. Manju Pathania Biswas, faculty at GIBS and Ms. Vartika, Instrumental Faculty, TSS.

- **Voices of the Street: NukkadNaatak**– Street performers delivered impactful theatrical acts, spreading awareness on social issues through humour, drama, and expressive storytelling. The judges of the event were Dr. Nidhi Sharma, faculty at GIBS and Mr. Vinod Kumar, Theatre Vertical Core Member of Udaan.
- **Trash to Treasure: Best out of Waste**– Participants transformed discarded materials into innovative, artistic creations, promoting sustainability and creative reuse. The judges of the event were Mr. Anuj Nanda, faculty at GIBS and Ms. Jaskaran, faculty, TSS.
- **Rangotsav: Rangoli Making** – Artists created vibrant and intricate rangoli designs, blending tradition with creativity using colors, flowers, and innovative materials. The judges of the event were Dr. Priyanka, faculty at GIBS and Ms. Avantika, faculty at TSS. The theme of the event was “Geometric Symmetry- Kaleidoscope- Inspired Patterns”.
- **Nach Baliye-A Western Dance (Duet) Competition**-The event featured duet performances based on Western dance styles such as Hip-Hop, Salsa, Contemporary, Jazz, and Ballroom. Participants were permitted to incorporate fusion elements; however, the core emphasis was required to remain on Western dance forms. The competition was judged by Dr. Anjali Gupta, Faculty at GIBS, and Ms. Himanshi, Faculty at TSS.
- **Beat Breakers- A Western Dance (Group) Competition**-The event showcased group performances centered on Western dance styles. Participants were allowed to perform on Western or Bollywood music, and the use of a medley of songs was permitted to enhance creativity and presentation. The competition was adjudicated by Dr. Kanchan Kumari, Faculty at GIBS, and Ms. Sujata, Faculty at TSS.
- **Brush & Blush- Make Up Artist (MUA) Competition**-This event provided a platform for participants to demonstrate their creativity and expertise in makeup artistry by showcasing innovative techniques, styles, and effective use of colors. Participants were required to design their makeup looks based on the theme

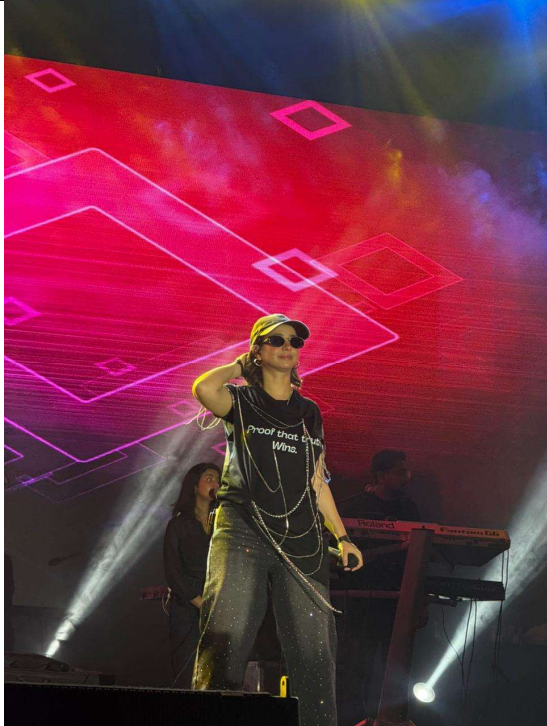
“Hollywood Movie Character”.The competition was judged by Dr. Mamta Rani, Faculty at GIBS, and Ms. Varsha, Faculty at TSS.

- **Divine Rhythms: Classical Dance (Solo)** – Solo dancers exhibited grace, discipline, and intricate movements in classical dance forms like Kathak and Bharatnatyam. The judges of the event were Dr. Puja Paul Srivastava, Faculty, GIBS and Ms. Hritika Aneesh, Classical Dancer, Nrityakala.
- **Style Spectrum: Fashion Show-** A high-energy runway event blending modern fashion with cultural heritage. The participants presented different themes like Bollywood, female power, aqua theme etc.The judges of the event were Dr. Manisha Kaushal Arora, Faculty, GIBS and Ms. Harika Gandhi, Senior Designer, Pearl Global Industries.

The Valedictory Ceremony was graced by Director Dr (Prof) Vkas Nath and Dean Ms Prachi Jindal, GIBS in the auditorium, TSS. The ceremony recognized the exceptional talent and participation of students through an award distribution segment, where winners of all competitions, including the Fashion Show, Nukkad Natak, etc. and the prestigious Star Zenith Award were presented awards. The Star Zenith of the Year Award, the most prestigious honor of Zenith 2026, was presented to Lakshmibai College, University of Delhi. This award is conferred upon the college that meets the eligibility criteria of participating in at least five events, securing a winner or runner-up position in at least three, and achieving an aggregate score above 100. The ceremony concluded on a high note with a Vote of Thanks, and the National Anthem.

The much-awaited Star Night at Zenith commenced on the main stage soon after the Valedictory Ceremony in the auditorium and turned into a spectacular celebration of music and entertainment, featuring the electrifying Punjabi pop singer Ms. Sunanda Sharma. The evening began with a soulful, slow performance by Sunanda Sharma, setting a captivating tone for the night. Soon, the atmosphere turned vibrant as the crowd erupted in excitement when she invited female participants to join her near the stage and match the vibe. She delivered a power-packed performance that had everyone dancing and singing along. Her electrifying stage presence, engaging interactions with the audience, and spontaneous dance
