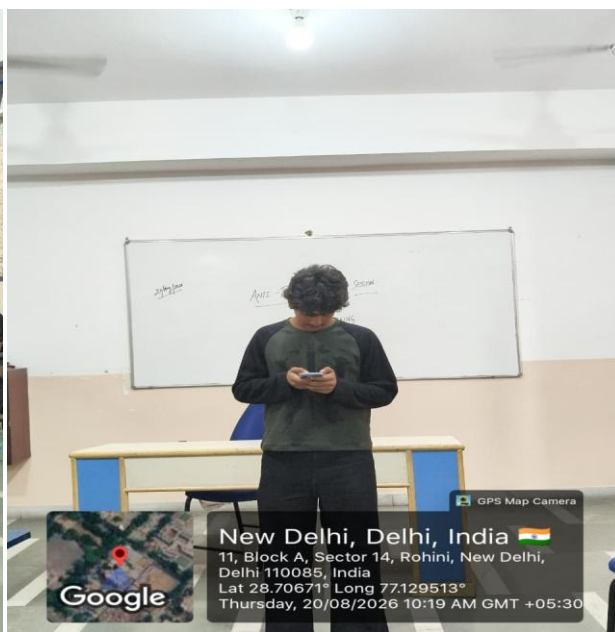


AWARENESS ON ANTI RAGGING 20TH AUGUST 2026 (MONDAY)
