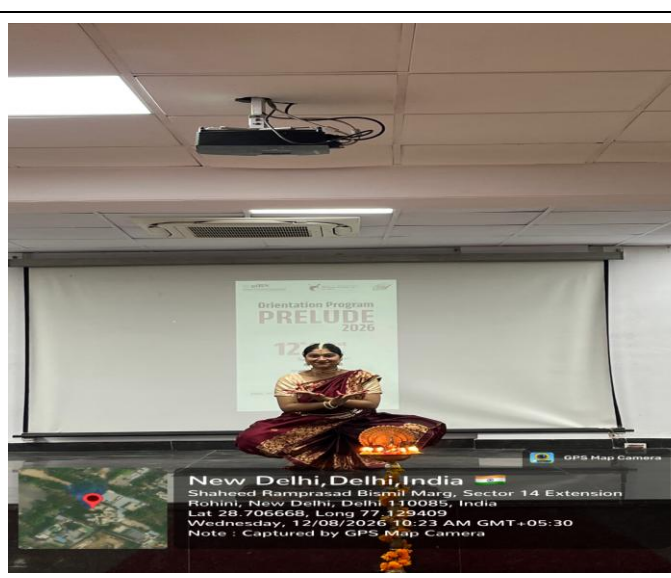


PRELUDE 2026 12TH AUGUST 2026 (Wednesday)
